For 2019-2020 students had the option of alternatively pursuing:

- Standard diploma which requires 4 credits of English, Math, Social Studies, and Science; 2 credits foreign language; 1 credit
 of Biblical Worldview, Computer Apps; 1.5 credits Enrichment; 0.5 credits of Speech and Study skills. 22.5 credits total
 required.
- Standard Distinguished diploma which requires the standard courses plus one of the choices: 1) an additional 2 credits in math or foreign language or 2) two or more Honors/AP/College credit courses.
